



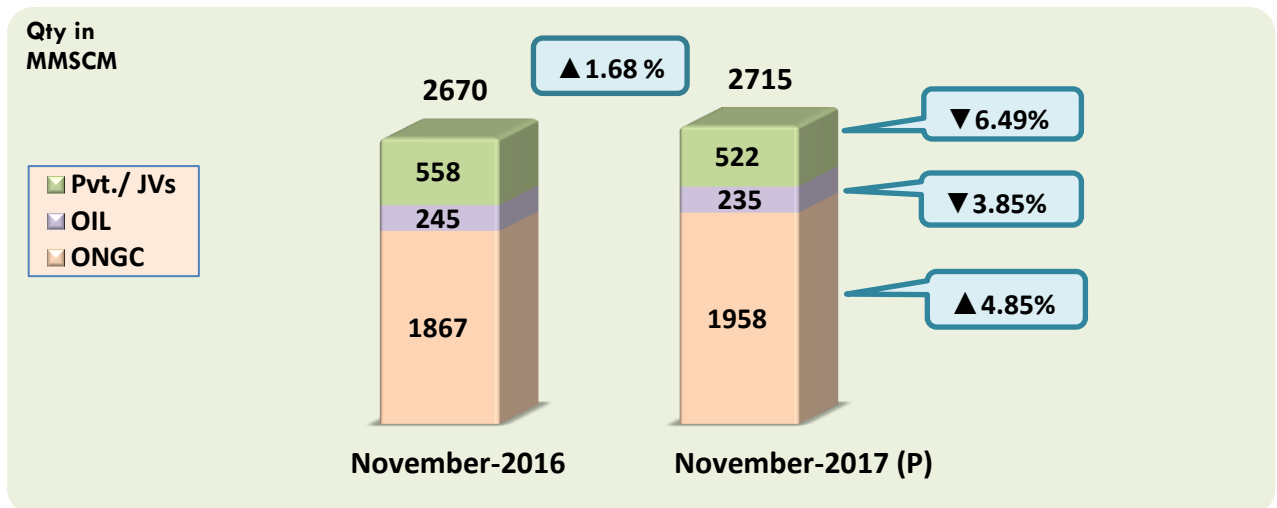

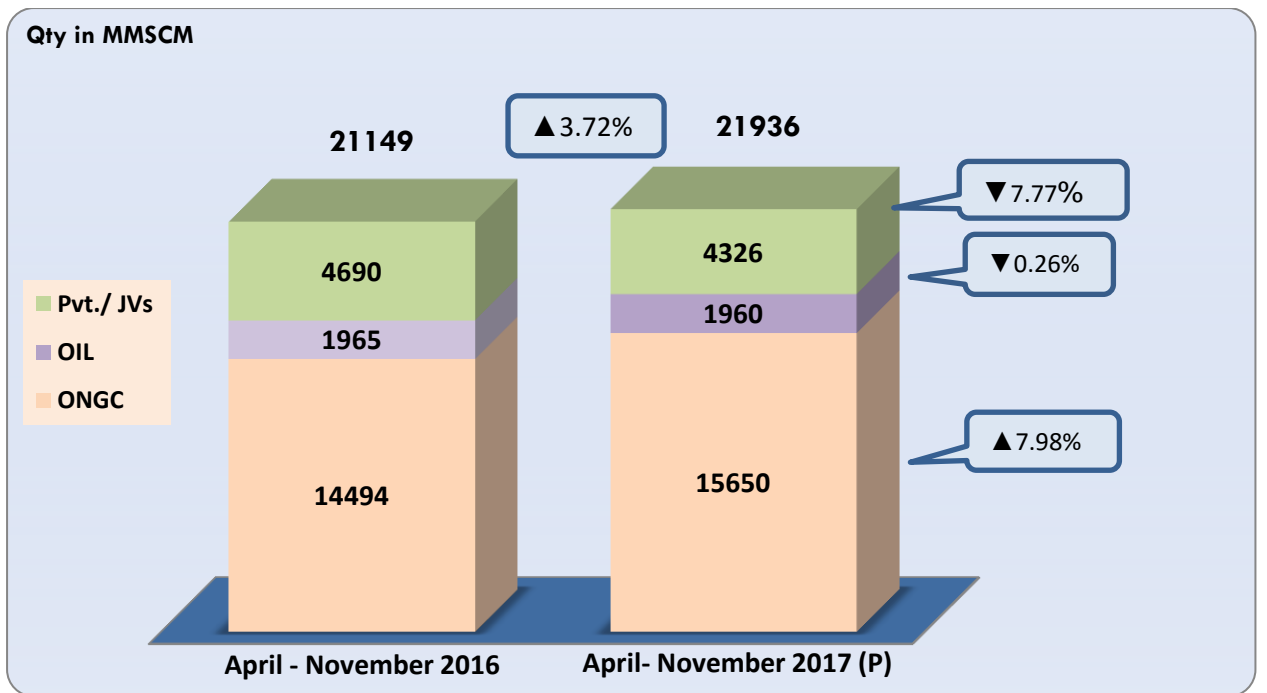
Monthly Report on Natural gas production, availability and consumption – November 2017

1. Highlights of the report for the month of November 2017 are as follows:

- Gross production for the month of November 2017 was 2714.87 MMSCM which was an increase by 1.68% over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Total import of LNG for the month of November 2017 was 2580.53 MMSCM which increased by 27.79% over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Natural gas available for sale for the month of November 2017 was 4746.11 MMSCM which was an increase of approximately 14.96 % over the corresponding month of the previous year.
- Total consumption by fertilizer, power, petrochemicals, sponge iron, refinery and other sectors for the month of November 2017 was 4471.56 MMSCM (149.05 MMSCMD).

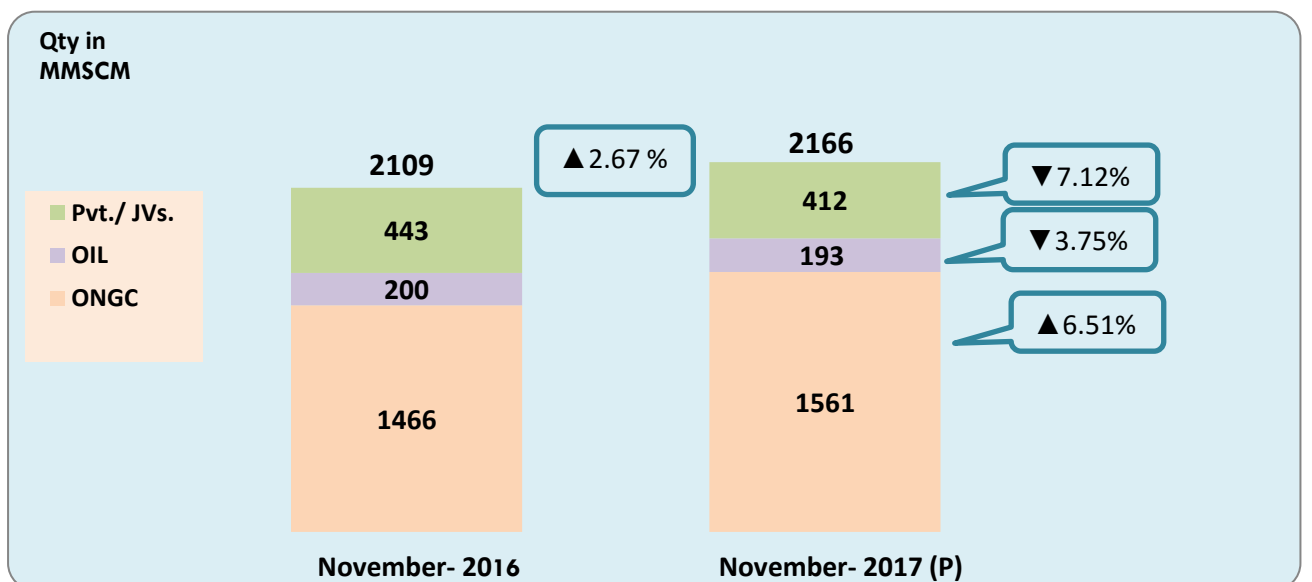
2. Domestic Natural Gas Gross Production:

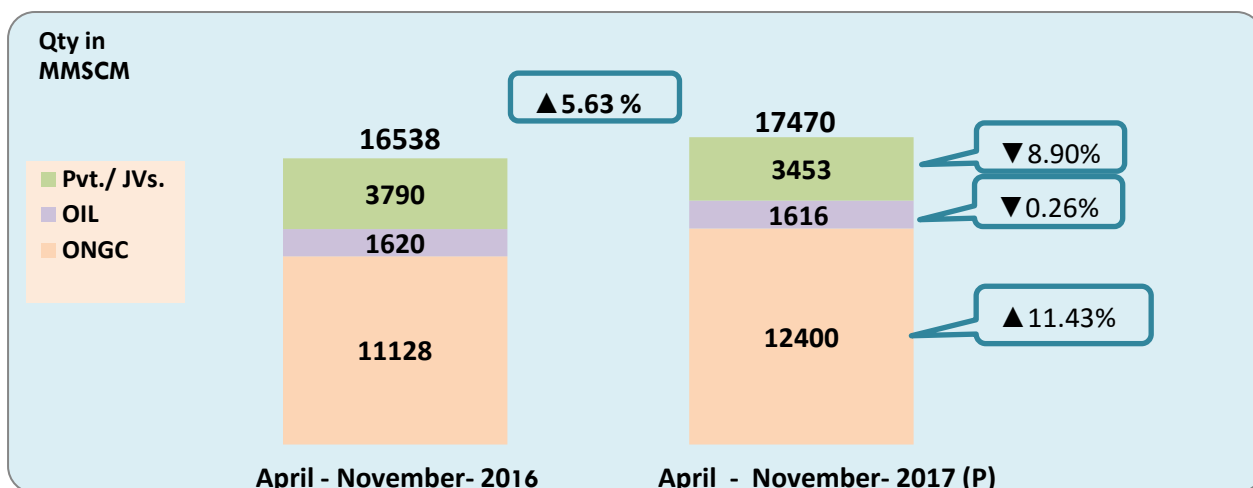




3. Domestic Natural Gas Net Production for Sale:

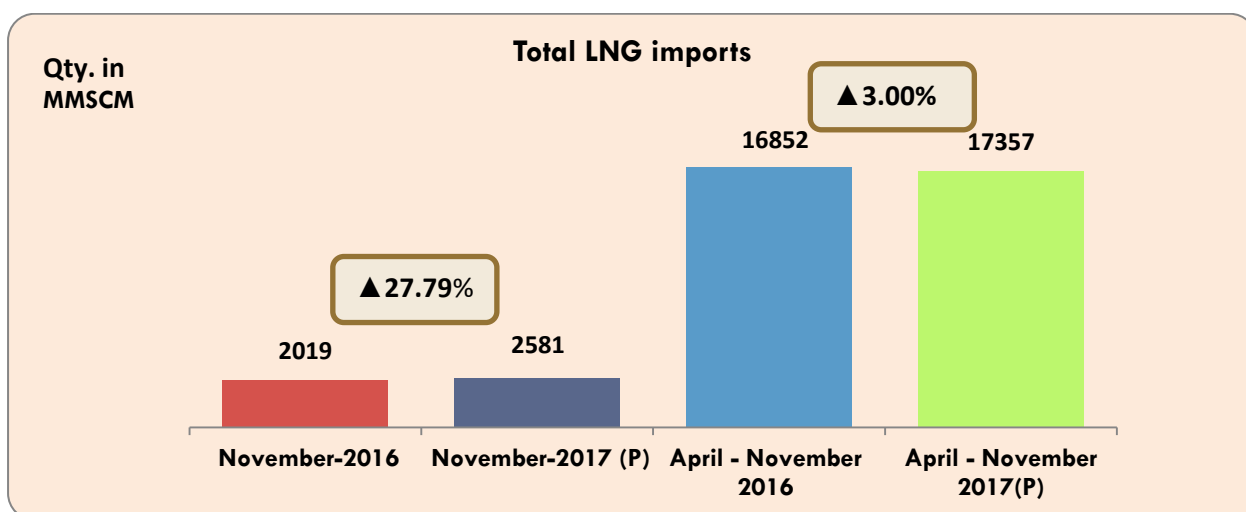
Natural Gas producing companies use some quantity of gas for their own use as internal consumption while some quantity of gas is flared as a part of technical requirement. After flare, loss and internal consumption by gas producing companies, the net production for sale of gas to other sectors like fertilizer, petrochemicals, CGD, refinery etc. and for fuel was approximately 79.77% of the gross production during November, 2017.





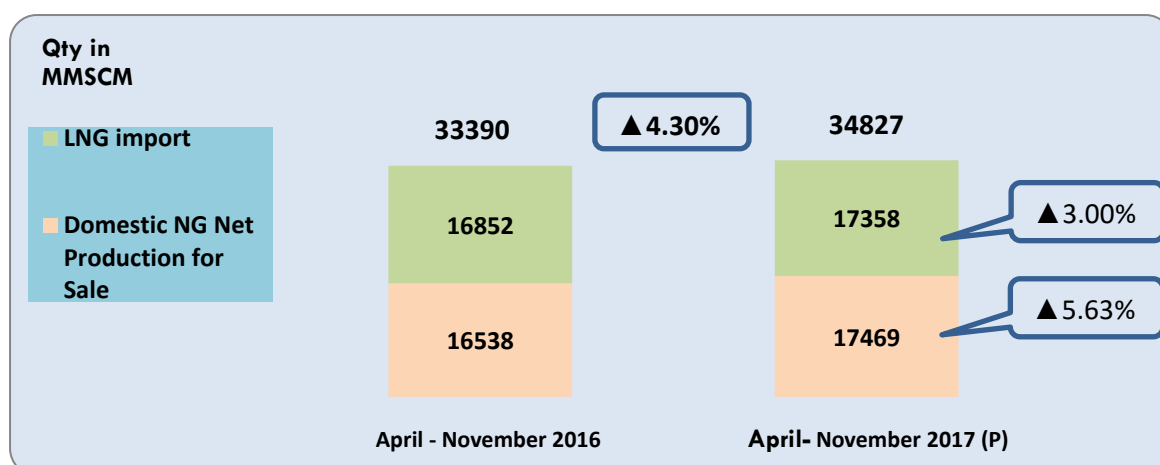
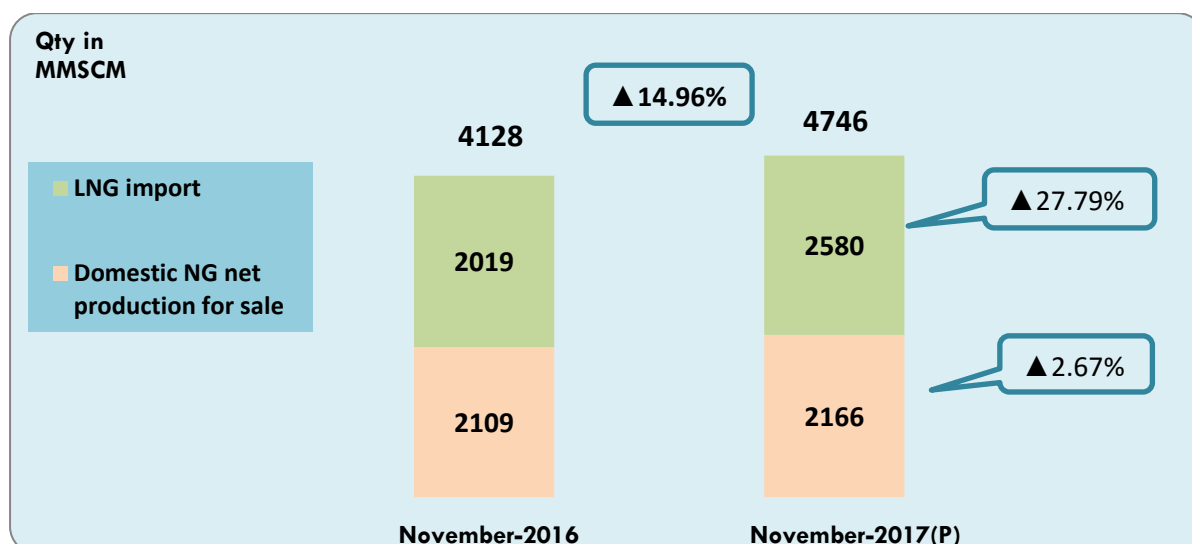
4. LNG imports:

LNG was procured during the month by Petronet LNG Ltd., GAIL (India) Ltd., Gujarat State Petroleum Corporation Ltd., Indian Oil Corporation Ltd., Reliance Industries Ltd., Torrent Power Ltd. and Bharat Petroleum Corporation Ltd.

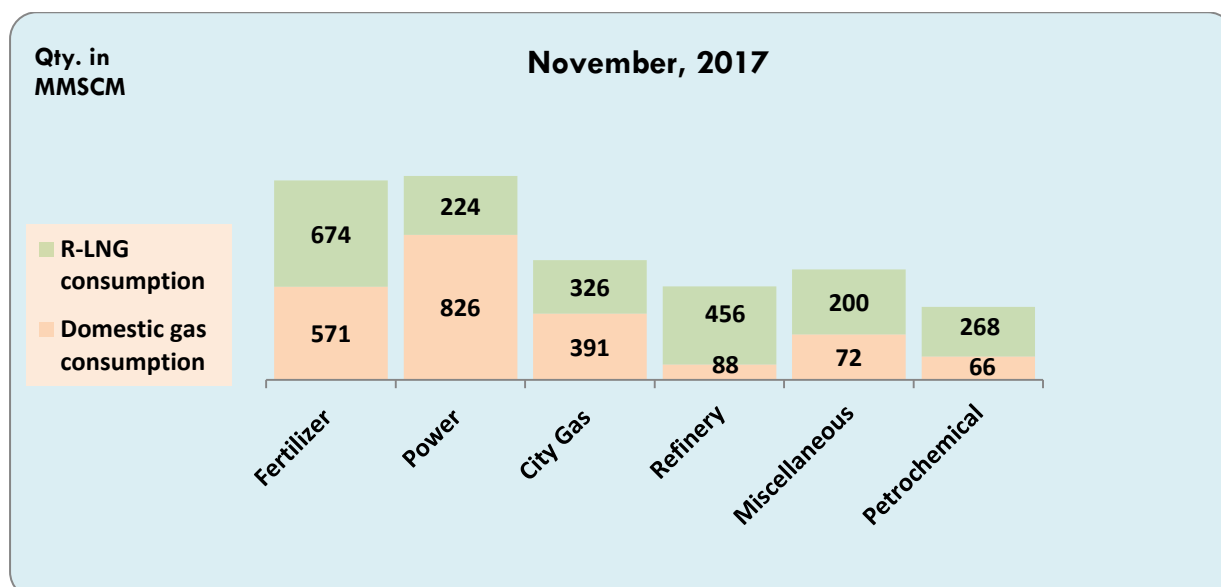


44.13% of the total LNG import in November, 2017 was from Qatar, 13.30% from Equatorial Guinea, 7.31% from Australia, 6.75% from Angola, 6.40% from Oman, 6.05% from Nigeria, 3.43% from France, 3.29% from Egypt, 3.22% from Algeria, 3.14% from Spain and 2.98% from UAE.
